We discussed mowing of cemeteries for year 2007. Robert Dupuis has agreed to continue mowing Bunker Hill, Ferrin, and Murray Hill cemeteries for 2007. Linda Denningham will attempt to find a volunteer or some older teen for a community project to mow Hill Center Church Cemetery.

The trustees also agreed to ask the Hill Trustees of the Trust Funds for the interest owed from the cemetery funds.

We agreed to purchase a restaurant gift certificate for Steve Rosen in appreciation of his volunteer work on the Bunker Hill Cemetery Fence Project. Linda Denningham will inquire of Trish Rosen as to what restaurants he enjoys.

We discussed dead branches and trees which have fallen in Bunker Hill and Murray Hill cemeteries. We would like to hire a person with the equipment to remove these branches and trees.

The cemetery trustees have received a check from the United Church of Christ in Concord, N.H. for \$6980.39. This money was donated to the Congregational Church in the old village of Hill by Dr. Gilman Kimball to maintain his parents' cemetery lot in the old village of Hill Cemetery. This lot was removed to Bunker Hill Cemetery in the early 1940's. The original principle was \$400.00. The money will be turned over to the Hill Trust Funds.

A cemetery meeting seminar will be held in Concord N.H. on June 19 2007 Denise Robie will E-mail Terry Knowles and let her know that the 3 cemetery trustees will attend.
