SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 26, 2007

PRESENT: Steve Farris, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)  
Mike came in later from about 8-8:30PM.

PUBLIC PRESENT: Bill Henry

MISC: Selectmen reviewed the Highway Department's equipment list.

ABATEMENT: Selectmen signed a property tax abatement for the Wasserman's (R4-24) for the period of 2004-2006.

SKIP OVERLOCK: Circle Three Sand & Gravel owner, Skip Overlock, came in to discuss the letters of complaint that were received recently concerning the gravel pit operations. He was given copies of the letters. He said that they have been working later than usual due to the state of emergency and that they do not usually go down Dearborn Road. They normally leave by 5PM. He said they will do anything they can to cooperate. He asked to have complaints forwarded to him as soon as we get them so that he can address them quickly. Skip agreed to run water and calcium on the road to keep the dust down. It was also agreed that signs would be put up indicating a 25mph speed limit and a "no thru trucking" sign will be placed on Dearborn Road. Also, engines brakes will not be allowed on Bootjack Road and Bootjack will be the only access to the pit. They will only operate from 7AM-5PM Monday – Friday and 7AM-12PM on Saturday. The only exception would be in the case of a declared state of emergency. A letter will be sent to notify the residents who filed a complaint of these conditions.

FIRE CHIEF: Matt stopped in briefly and said that the tanker failed inspection at "Winni Truck".

MISC: Selectmen will post for another dump attendant to work Saturdays only.  
Selectmen looked a tax maps for the remainder of the evening.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30PM.
