SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES  
APRIL 3, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

GARY DAVID: Gary expressed concern about the Class VI Road policy. Growth control was also discussed. Gary Fouts was also present during this part of the meeting.

POLICE CHIEF: Donald asked when to expect the pay increases as some of the employees have been inquiring. Steve said that they will be made retroactive as of the usual time raises are given after town meeting.

MISC: Steve suggested looking into getting some awnings for the windows on the side of the building in an effort to save energy during the summer months. An application from the "Friends" to use the town hall for an Easter egg hunt was approved for April 7<sup>th</sup>.

DONATION: Mark made a motion to not pay the hospital donation even though the budget committee added it back into the budget. All agreed as state statues currently prohibit towns from making purely charitable donations.

CLASS VI ROAD POLICY: Steve brought up the issue of the Class VI road policy again. He sited the reason for abolishing the policy is due to the fact that the town voted down the zoning ordinance amendments including defining frontage. Mike said that he would not do anything without consulting the town attorney. Mark concurred. Selectmen agreed to have the town attorney come to a meeting in which the planning board will be invited to attend to discuss this issue before making any decisions.

WATER ISSUE: Mark spoke about the water situation on lot V-105 belonging to Jessie Johnson. He said that there is a lawsuit in progress. They discussed how best to handle this. Later when Gerry Desrochers came in, he was asked to take a water sample to see if there was any chlorine in it to determine where the water is coming from.

APPOINTMENTS: Selectmen signed an appointment form for Thomas Wallace as Water Commissioner. Mike signed the appointment form for Bob Helmers to be reappointed to the Planning Board, but neither Steve nor Mark felt that he should be reappointed.
