

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 30, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow

ROAD AGENT: The Borough Road bridge closure was discussed. Discussed the possibility of widening portions of the road. Also discussed the Wythe issue. Dean expressed concern about what Kathy had told him. The Board said they had not given her written permission to put the wall back up as they do not have any say in that area since the wall does not belong to the town. Dean said that we already have easement to discharge the water there per state law. He also stated that when they found the break in the wall in 1990, they moved a rock to prevent them from having to go up there every time it rained. Mark said that he told them that if the tree was removed that they want cut down, it would ruin their driveway. Dean gave a review of the tree clean-up from the recent storm. He will get the RSA reference concerning the easement and blind driveways for next weeks meeting. He also said that the town should never issue a "blind driveway" sign.

RON TRUDEL: Mr. Trudel came in after receiving a letter from the Board about his unlicensed junkyard. It was stated that unregistered trailers on the property are considered to be another residence which is not allowed per town zoning. He said that he is cleaning up his yard and is always bringing stuff in and then getting rid of it. He pressed the issue of who made the complaint and questioned why he was the only one receiving this notice, citing that there are many other properties similar to his in town. He agreed to register the vehicles on his property, but said there is nothing else on his property that should be of concern to anyone. Mr. Trudel said the Board is not allowed to inspect his property. He asked if storage containers are allowed and was told that should not be an issue. He also complained about his neighbor who he claims pushed junk tires onto his property.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry said the water dept. decided to start talking with Linda Byers about buying the water line and an easement down the road. Discussed the water dept. improvements and how it could be run better in the future.

MISC: Steve asked if the other Board members had taken a look at the town of Bristol's web-site. Mike questioned who would maintain it. Gerry asked who would host it. They discussed what it would contain.
