

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
DECEMBER 27, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

YEAR END BUDGET: Selectmen voted to encumber funds for the following purposes: Culvert replacement - \$15,000, installation of a dry hydrant at Thompson's pond - \$6,400, development of a town web-site - \$1,500, repair and installation of storm windows in the library - \$700.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Selectmen discussed buying used equipment for the department as well as general highway business.

MISC: Selectmen signed the 2008 HealthTrust agreement for the town's health insurance coverage. A building permit application was approved for John Lynch to build a garage at 195 Lynch Road (R4-19). Signed an intent to cut for John Lynch (R4-19).

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry gave the Board the water department's 2008 budget proposal. Mark asked him if the water department would take over the dry hydrant that will be installed at Thompson's pond. Gerry felt the fire dept. would be responsible for that as it is not in the water dept's jurisdiction and they have no use for it. Selectmen signed the paperwork for USDA grant funding for the dept.

POLICE CHIEF: Donald gave the Board the figure for the new cruiser with an estimated cost of \$30,000. Mark said that they have received complaints about one of the officers.
