SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 30, 2007

Present: John Nesteruk, Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Linda Henry (Assistant)

PAULA MCDONOUGH: Paula asked about the Parks and Rec's appropriation for the Lassie League. Selectmen appointed her as a P & R member; term to expire in "2010". She expressed concern about the Board not receiving a letter from the school principal concerning moving the shed as she has lined up some help to move it. She also asked about obtaining some town reports. Later, Paula returned to ask about the P & R committee fund raising and said that she would like to put a concession stand at the park during ballgames.

TOWN HALL: Selectmen approved an application from the "Friends of the P & R" to use the town hall for a children's dance to be held on February 9th pending receipt of the insurance certificate.

KATHY DRONEY: Kathy came in to ask about her application to use the town hall for basketball practice with her children. She was told that a fee of \$75 plus a \$100 deposit would need to be collected. She declined the offer.

ABATEMENT: Selectmen reviewed a letter of recommendation from Avitar concerning settling the case with the Wasserman's on Murray Hill Road (R4-24) before it goes to the BTLA. Selectmen agreed to settle per their recommendation.

MISC: Selectmen accepted the proposal from Milton-Cat for a three year contract for maintenance on the generator. Tax maps were reviewed and finalized. Briefly discussed purchasing a new cruiser for the Police Dept. Also discussed gravel pits in reference to RSA 155: E, IV.

MARTHA JORDAN: Martha said that the library is accepting donations for some old shelving. Also discussed fixing the windows in the library.
