SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 28, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)  
Mike had to leave the meeting early.

DAVID THOMSON: David came in thinking that the assessor was going to be here, but he was not able to make it. He again questioned his assessment. Mike said that a DRA representative will be attending the meeting about commercial assessments on July 10th as well as the assessor to inform the other Selectmen that Tuesday night's motion to get rid of commercial assessments is illegal.

FERRIN STREET RESIDENTS: A group of residents came in to ask the Board to allow Vicki Plante to park a bus on town owned property. Mrs. Bernasconi read aloud a letter addressing their concerns. Selectmen responded that a town ordinance will not allow the bus to be stored on town property and that she is not in violation of any ordinance. It was suggested that she park the bus at the school, but that would be decided by them. Steve will check on this. One resident said she was told by Steven Plante that they have 3 extra bedrooms in their basement and expressed a concern about their septic system.

ROAD AGENT: Dean, Dale and Tim attended the meeting. Dean said the 98 truck is out of commission and got permission for Tim to take his CDL license test on the other truck. Dean talked about a possible dispute between residents on Addison Road and Route 3A about dragging horses on the road creating problems. Discussed the FEMA meeting which will be held on July 9<sup>th</sup> and possible projects for the 404 program. Mark asked Dean to change the turn around on Range Road as the property owner does not want it there anymore. Moving the "end of town maintained road" sign on King Road was discussed per Cheryl Baines request. Dean said the placement of the sign does not mean that is the actual line where the Class V road ends and that the end of the Class V portion is very close to her driveway. Mark questioned the road crew cleaning up the dump. Dean responded that the dump crew does not do it so they have to. Developing a road policy was mentioned. Mark said they voted and passed as a Board weeks ago and a notice was put in the road agents mailbox to come in every Thursday. He asked if Dean had received the memo. Dean expressed concern about how the department is being treated. Mark made a comment about the Wheeler brothers which angered Dean. Dean said that he wanted decisions to be made by the whole board.

FRANK MARSH: Frank asked if the town had put stakes up in his front yard and was told that no one from the town had done this.
