SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 6, 2007

Present: John Nesteruk, Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Linda Henry (Assistant)

FIRE CHIEF: Matt expressed concern about the road crew not plowing out the fire station in a timely fashion during the latest snowstorm. He also asked about the Board issuing oil burner permits as part of the building permit process as required by law (RSA 153:5).

MOYERS: Donald and Kim Moyer attended the meeting to discuss the Borough Road bridge project per the Board's request. Steve said that the old bridge will be removed. There will need to be a bridge abutment on the corner of their property and a right of way will need to be obtained. The Moyer's said they would agree to that.

PAULA MCDONOUGH: Paula asked where they should move the shed when it is moved off of school property this weekend. Dean will be getting it to use at the highway garage.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into non public session at 8:45 to discuss an assistance case with a potential client. Non public session ended at 9:00.

MISC: Selectmen reviewed the newest version of the tax maps and found additional errors. They reviewed the "Worker's Comp Light Duty Policy" draft and made revisions. Discussed warrant articles and the upcoming town meeting. Selectmen accepted Jim Karwocki's proposal to repair the Selectmen's office after the flooding damage last spring. They also looked at the leaky roof in the building.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry came in for the town reports. He was concerned that they were not available yet.
