

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
MAY 31, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)
Mike Brady came in at 7:30PM.

JOHN JORDAN: John came in to discuss hooking up his trailer to utilities on his lot on Poverty Pond Road (R8-16).

ASSISTANCE CASE: Non public session held from 6:40PM to 7:00PM to meet with a potential assistance client.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Dale Wheeler attended the meeting in lieu of the road agent who is on a temporary medical leave. Discussed the best way to repair the damage caused to the Borough Road Bridge due to the accident. Engineers suggested installing jersey barriers since the bridge is going to be replaced. Discussed creating policies for the department and having someone come in each week to discuss what they are planning to do and what has been done. Steve made a motion to accept some free software to help track maintenance of the roads. All agreed. Dale said that someone has dumped materials at the Poverty Pond gravel pit and that some of the rubbish indicated that it came from 526 Currier Road.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry picked up a couple of tax maps. He said that Edmunds will take a look at the water lines in the brook. Mark offered to mow the area around the pump house.

TOWN OFFICE ISSUES: Steve suggested having the town office painted as the school is planning to paint their building this year. He suggested installing a new drain and taking advantage of the school doing some paving to fix the flooding problem in the basement. Also suggested getting a quote to build a small retaining wall. Steve suggested having some work done in the basement and looking into getting a fire proof vault next year.

CLOUGH ROAD ISSUE: Discussed last night's meeting with the engineers and Bart. They will put together a quote to repair the road. Steve said that if Mr. Greenwalt did not get a dredge & fill permit then the town can legally make him put it back to its original condition.
