

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
MAY 8, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

POLICE CHIEF: Michael Moses came in to express concern about the Bootjack Road gravel operation continuing longer into the day than they had agreed to. Donald said that he cannot enforce a letter in regards to the restrictions imposed. The restrictions would have to be in the form of an ordinance. Fine could not exceed \$100 which goes to the town. Speed limit fines go to the state. Linda will contact the LGC for sample ordinances.

ROAD AGENT: Dean spoke about his concern with a drainage issue on Clough Road as he is trying to fix the road. He said we need to obtain an easement from Dean Greenwalt who owns land on Clough Road. Discussed keeping the old dump truck if there was any use for it. Discussed expenses incurred from the flooding event. Dean said that he has not met with John Jordan yet about the work that John wants to do on Poverty Pond Road.

TRANSFER STATION: Steve made a motion to hire Glenn Bartis as another transfer station attendant. All agreed. He will be offered \$8.25 to start. It was mentioned that he is also interested in doing the mowing.

MISC: Mark mentioned that he received a phone call from someone who expressed concern about the Jones's gravel pit. Selectmen felt that it was a civil issue. Mark also said that his brother looked at the town lots and determined that there was nothing worth harvesting and felt that Robert Summers did build on town land on Borough Road. Discussed trading lots with the Robie's and Mike agreed with the Board's decision made at Thursday's meeting not to pursue this. Discussed selling three town owned parcels taken for taxes. Selectmen signed an abatement for Derelyn Padula (R12-9).

WAGES: Mark made a motion to give a 3% wage increase to all employees except for Dean who will receive a 7% increase to help offset the new health insurance contribution. Mike yes, Steve no. Motion carries. Raises will be made retroactive from March 18th.

TOWN HALL USE: Selectmen authorized use of the town hall on June 2nd for Steve Whitmore to hold a graduation party for his son, pending receipt of insurance certificate and agreement to fees.
