SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
NOVEMBER 29, 2007

SHAUN LAGUEUX: Shaun, from New England Forestry Consultants spoke about his findings on timber harvesting and access to town lots. Suggested doing the work around the pond during February vacation when school is out. He expects a small net gain to the town in the area of \$1,000-\$2,000. He would charge \$45 per hour in the village and a percentage basis on the King Road lot. He also apologized for his lack of understanding on the road work procedure in regards to the timber harvesting project on Poverty Pond Road. He explained what he had done to the road. Selectmen said their main concern is the Class V section of the road. He anticipates that they will be working up there for a period of three years.

MISC: Steve said a resident on Currier Road has been leaving trash outside of the dump during closed hours. He will confirm who this is so a letter can be sent as this is against a town ordinance. Steve reviewed our zoning ordinance to clarify whether or not windmills are allowed. All agreed that it is an accessory use and that a residence must be on the property as well. Discussed installing additional lighting at the transfer station. Discussed selling the town owned lot on Borough Road (R3-9-9) as the abutting property owner is still interested in purchasing it.
