SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 9, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

KATHY WYTHE: Kathy and her daughter came in to discuss what the town is liable for in regards to their water run-off issues. They gave the Board some information that they felt was pertinent to this case. They said they are only asking the town to do something about the tree and stonewall that they feel is part of the problem. After a brief discussion, they left the meeting with no resolution to the issue.

FIRE CHIEF: Briefly discussed building a new fire station. Matt said he would prefer to just add on to the existing building.

POLICE CHIEF: Donald said that he would be at the public hearing tomorrow night concerning the proposed Keezar Road development in case of any problems.

MISC: Selectmen denied a current use application for Faith Knowles (R3-48) as she did not qualify. Discussed purchasing used equipment at auction. Signed intent to cut for D. Blakely Hoar Trust (R14-5, R8-17). Approved a building permit for David Woods of 372 Bunker Hill Road (R12-55-2) for two sheds.

SHAUN LAGUEUX: Shaun from NE Forestry Consultants came in to discuss his findings per the Board's request a few weeks ago. He said that in "1998" the town paid a forester to do a report after the ice storm. He will try to get a copy of that report from him. He gave a brief presentation about each area in the village in terms of what timber is available and hazardous trees. He does not envision any profit to the town at this time. He will send a proposal with the work order. Steve said a lot on King Road needs to be logged and asked him to also look at the transfer station lot.

TOWN CLERK: Desiree gave the Board a copy of all the town ordinances to be put on a town web-site when it is ready. She felt they may want to review them as some of them are very outdated. She also said that she received a grant from the State for vital record preservation. Selectmen gave the ok to have motion sensors installed in her office with these funds. Also discussed installing a vault in the basement.
