SELECTMENS MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 27, 2007

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

Due to lack of a quorum, the meeting did not start until 7pm when Mike came in. Mark joined the meeting at 7:15. In the interim, Steve spoke to the road agent about highway department business.

ANDREW DENTON: Mr. Denton came in on behalf of the Hill Village Bible Church in regards to being taxed on the parcel they recently purchased adjacent to the church. He said that he spoke to the town assessor and does not agree with him that the parcel is not being used for religious purposes. He said that they are using the building on the property for storage of the pastor's belongings and using the land for church activities. Also discussed the possibility of doing a lot merger. Mr. Denton was given an abatement application with the understanding that they could not apply for an abatement until after the final tax bill of the year was issued in November.

MISC: Selectmen discussed the proposed Keezar Road project and the upcoming public hearing. Discussed wind turbines in relation to increasing revenue and how it fits into current zoning regulations. Discussed water dept. improvements. Steve suggested hiring a joint grant writer. He also said that State representatives are interested in holding a legislation night in town.
