

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
APRIL 1, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

WATER DEPT: Mike made a motion to approve the grant and loan for the water department from the USDA. All agreed.

ROAD AGENT: Dean asked if we have a written contract with Circle 3 for sand. Mike stated that it is verbal not written. Dean is concerned about the cost of sand and salt. He was told to buy it wherever it is cheaper. Discussed purchasing a used loader. It seems they are difficult to get.

WHEELERS: Gail and Fred Wheeler came in to discuss putting their land into current us. They submitted an application.

MISC: Discussed the budget break-down due to lack of specific information from the budget committee. Discussed the highway dept. in terms of the harsh winter's effect on the overtime budget. The assessing contract was signed. We will not be doing the current use update this year due to budget cuts. A letter was signed to the Trustee of the Trust Funds requesting the Ferrin Fund interest and \$9,800 from the Highway Heavy Equipment Capital Reserve Fund to reimburse the general fund for the new sander. Another letter was signed authorizing \$64,409 coming from surplus to be deposited into the Road Improvement Capital Reserve Fund per town meeting approval. Selectmen signed the MS-2. An intent to excavate was signed for J.P. Morrison (R1-28).

NON PUBLIC SESSION: NPS began at 7:45PM to meet with an assistance applicant. NPS ended at 8PM.

BUILDING PERMITS: An application to build a new home was approved for Central Lakes Development, Shop Road (V-136). Applications were approved for Hill Design on Route 3A (V-115) to demolish an old home and barn.

Meeting adjourned at 8:40PM.
