ROAD AGENT: Discussed general highway dept. business and the purchase of a used loader. John will be attending an auction in North Woodstock in April to see if a good used loader can be obtained. Mark said that he heard that cold patch may be difficult to get this year. Talked about a location for a salt shed and pre-buying salt to save money.

NON-PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 7:35PM to meet with an assistance client. Also discussed other pending assistance cases after the client left. NPS ended at 8:05PM.

MISC: Selectmen signed various yield and gravel tax warrants. Also signed an intent to cut for State of NH, William H. Thomas State Forest and Judd Brothers Enterprise (R3-17).

TOWN CLERK: Desiree inquired about her wage increase now that the town budget has been finalized. She also said that the IRS mileage reimbursement rate is currently 50.5 cents and felt the town should increase their rate as well. Our current reimbursement is 40 cents per mile. She said that her printer stopped working and received permission to purchase a new one. She also pointed out that it is the Selectmen's responsibility to fill vacancies on boards and committees and inquired about appointments.
