SELECTMENS MEETING
AUGUST 26, 2008

JAMES BLACKKEY: Mr. Blackkey asked to have his property card changed to reflect that his home is not a mobile home anymore since renovations have been done. Selectmen will look into it.

NED GORDON: Mr. Gordon asked to have some rocks moved away from his property on Borough Rd. that were relocated there during some road work. The road agent will be asked to look into that. He also asked if Windfall Road was a Class VI road as he wants to put in a camp and was told that it is Class VI.

JEFF LEHMAN: Mr. Lehman inquired about installing a locked security gate on Axtel Road as he is concerned about trespassers. Since Axtel is a town public road he was told he could not lock it.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry asked if the road agent could bring some gravel to the pump house to repair a wash-out. John will talk to Dean.

BUILDING WORK: Selectmen prepared a list of town contractors to send a bid request for the repair work to be done on the basement area of the town office building. It will also be posted around town. All bids must be received by September 16th.

MISC: Mike made a motion to deny the abatement request for the Carey property on Currier Rd. (R12-42) due to the assessor's recommendation. All agreed. The MS-1 form was signed. Approved an application for the girl scouts to hold their weekly meetings at the school on Monday evenings and the boy scouts to hold their meetings there on Thursday nights. General discussion took place regarding the King Road washout issue and Class VI roads.
