

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
FEBRUARY 12, 2008

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)
Steve left early to attend the School Budget Public Hearing.

ANNE BLANCHARD: Anne filed a complaint against her neighbors on Old Town Road about their dogs running loose and causing problems for her. She said that the Police Dept. had returned her calls in the past, but the last four calls had not been returned.

ROAD COMPLAINT: Ricky Morrill and another gentleman came in to complain about the condition of the roads.

NON-PUBLIC SESSION: NPS was entered into at 6:50PM. Bob Dupuis and Gary David were in attendance to discuss a police department issue. NPS ended at 7PM.

MISC: Briefly discussed getting a bin to put the tires in at the transfer station. Discussed the highway department in regards to their plowing, sanding and salting techniques. They have currently depleted their supply of salt and do not know when more will be available. The sand is apparently frozen. Signed an intent to cut for Steve Farris (R12-46). Determined that town meeting will be held on Thursday, March 13th at 7PM.

ANDREW DENTON: Andrew brought in a proposed warrant article concerning donating a portion of town land to the Hill Village Bible Church. They are currently leasing this property. He stated that they will agree to maintain the right of way in perpetuity.

TOWN CLERK: Desiree brought to the Selectmen's attention that the IRS is currently suggesting 48.5 cents per mile for mileage reimbursement. The town is presently paying 40 cents per mile. She said that the Historical Society has asked to use the basement of the town office building to do research as their building is not heated. They will need to talk to the Selectmen directly. She also pointed out that we need to fix the lights in the building as they are not working properly.
