SELECTMENS MEETING  
FEBRUARY 19, 2008

Present: Steve Farris, Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: Selectmen reviewed a letter received from a gentleman who would like to purchase the property that his uncle once owned which now belongs to the town. He will be contacted to discuss this with the Board. Briefly discussed meeting with the Police Chief. He was contacted to come in tonight to discuss a personnel matter, but did not respond to the request. Discussed getting a bin for tires at the transfer station. The NRRA will be contacted to install one. Signed intent to cut forms for: Raymond Robie (R11-5) and Roger and Randy Robie (R12-12). Signed the warrant for town meeting.

FIRE CHIEF: Matt questioned the closure of Murray Hill Road the other night as he had no knowledge of this at the time. He wondered where the Emergency Manager was. Steve said the Police Chief told him that they were not preventing people from using the road, but advised residents that the road was bad. There was some confusion about that. Apparently several residents had to spend the night at the fire station. Selectmen were not informed about the closure and the lack of communication was a concern for everyone. Matt also expressed concern and submitted a copy of a letter that he wrote to the Franklin Police Dept. about being contacted in the event of any accident in town due to the lack of medical training in the Police Dept.

HIGHWAY DEPT: There was much discussion about the condition of the town roads due to the extreme weather this year. Concern was expressed about the management of the highway dept. Many opinions were expressed concerning better methods to take care of the roads.

A Public Hearing was held to discuss the possible bond for a new fire tanker. Minutes of this hearing are attached under separate cover.
