

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMEN'S MEETING
JULY 15, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

JIM CAREY: Mr. Carey submitted an abatement application for his property on Currier Road. He asked the Board to have the assessor take another look at his property due to some changes regarding the properties surrounding him. Selectmen agreed.

GARD DAVID: Gary briefly spoke about correcting some drainage issues in the back of the town office building.

JOHN NESTERUK: John was appointed to the Zoning Board with his term to expire in "2011". Mike performed the swearing in procedure.

WATER DEPT: Commissioner Desrochers attended the meeting to discuss the need to hold a special town meeting in order to correct a warrant article from the 2007 town meeting. This action would seek to change the water improvements project from a revenue bond to a general obligation bond. Gerry had already done the preliminary work and was told by the proper authorities that there was no need to obtain court approval since there is no appropriation involved. He presented correspondence from the town attorney and another attorney regarding the matter. Selectmen still felt it was necessary to involve the budget committee. Gerry will contact Nancy Chaddock, budget committee chair, to let her know what is going on. He presented a time line to follow so that the meeting could be held as soon as possible. Mike made a motion to hold the special town meeting, John agreed. Motion carried. Meeting will be held on August 21st. Other various documents were signed in regards to the water improvements project.

MISC: Selectmen signed a letter to Mike Stanley, Trustee of the Trust Funds, requesting reimbursement for expenses incurred for the loader and dump body as approved at town meeting in the amount of \$50,696.27. This money to come from the Highway Heavy Equipment Capital Reserve fund.
