

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
JULY 8, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)
Mark Dow will be absent for about a month as he is attending a class.

MISC: John said that he spoke to the owner of TLC Tree Service and he is not going to ask for payment for services from last year due to some confusion. Selectmen agreed to pay for services rendered for cutting down the tree on New Chester recently. Briefly discussed replacing the garage doors at the town shed. Discussed the Circle 3 gravel pit. Selectmen will ask Steve Punderson to attend a meeting to discuss some maintenance issues on Clough Road. Selectmen reviewed information from the Town of Bristol concerning possibly joining in on a fuel consortium with several other area town's and schools. Linda will check to see if we can still participate with the Frankin school district and obtain some additional information from Bristol before committing to anything.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Tim Henry attended the meeting to give the Board some information on what the department has been doing recently. They are in the process of widening Borough Road. Tim mentioned that the backhoe needs 4 new tires. He has priced them out and estimates a cost of \$1600-\$1700. It was suggested that he check with the State to see if they can be obtained any cheaper through them. John expressed concern about when the department takes vacation time. Tim said that one man should be on duty in case there are any issues to attend to. It was felt that the Road Agent should be managing this issue.

TRISH ROSEN: Trish expressed concern about her neighbors on King Road using a scare cannon 24 hours a day to scare away birds that are apparently bothering their animals. She wanted to know if anything could be done about the noise. The noise ordinance was reviewed, but the Board felt that this did not apply to it as it is an agricultural product. They said they will look into it, but they are not sure anything can be done.

TAX DEEDS: Selectmen signed a deed waiver for the Coolberth's on Eastside Lane (R1-6-2) as payment arrangements have been made with them. Letters to the other property owners that are up for tax collector deed will be sent this week in an effort to collect the past due taxes or make some kind of payment arrangements with the property owners.
