

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
JUNE 3, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

ANNE BLANCHARD: Anne came in as a follow-up to her previous complaints concerning dogs on her property and harassment from her neighbor. It was suggested that she file a written complaint if she sees the dogs in her yard again or post no trespassing signs on the property. Also discussed the option of going to court over the matter.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 6:35PM to meet with a potential assistance client. Nps ended at 6:55PM. Later after discussing the issue, the Board agreed to pay \$500 worth of bills for this client.

DEAN GREENWALT: Dean asked about diverting water from his property on Clough Road. Since widening the road, he states that a lot of water is coming off the hill. He alleges that the water bar has not been maintained. This water bar is supposed to be maintained by his neighbor, Steve Punderson. The Selectmen told him they would look into it.

MISC: A letter of appreciation for Joe Mahoney was signed for the work he did on the flagpole. A letter to continue participating in the CCNTR regional planning activities was signed. Signed appointment form for Glen Eaton to continue as Trustee of the Trust Funds with his term to expire in 2011. The 2008A property tax warrant was signed.

CURRENT USE: The following current use applications were approved: Fred Wheeler (R13-34), David Thomson (R10-5-1, R10-5-1A, R10-5-2A and R10-17), Ronald Hughes (R10-31), Walter Waring (R10-2-3), Steven Farris (R12-45, R12-46), Thomas Whitman (R8-2).

DAN ST.ONGE: Dan asked about putting a pond on his property on Dearborn Road in case of fire. He was told to contact the State for information.

BUS SHELTER: Selectmen agreed to allow a girl scout in town to repair and repaint the bus shelter in the village so that she can receive a community service badge. Linda told the Board that she had spoken to the principal and he said the shelter does not belong to the school and it was not a PTO project.

BUILDING: Selectmen discussed what could be done to keep water out of the basement in the town office building after some damage was sustained in the office and entry way. John will contact a few people in town to see if anyone is interested in doing the work.
