MARCH 4, 2008

BRIDGE PROJECT: Discussed the funding for the Borough Road Bridge project and determined that both Bristol and Hill would budget for half the cost of construction to make it easier on the cash flow. The figure will need to be amended at town meeting.

MISC: Selectmen signed the contract for ambulance services with the Town of Bristol for \$23,444. Discussed road conditions having received many complaints from residents.

HAZARD MIT. PLAN: Mike made a motion to adopt the Hazard Mitigation Plan. All agreed. The document will be forwarded to Jane Hubbard so that the plan can be finalized by FEMA.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Steve reported that we would need to make some adjustments at town meeting to reflect the actual ambulance charge for the year as well as the bridge project change. Gerry said that we need to place a handicap sign at the head of the designated parking spot at the town office and the handle on the door needs to be replaced with a level type handle. He also expressed concern about the water damage in the basement. He asked if the water dept. could use the loader to unbury the hydrants.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: NPS began at 8:05PM to meet with Police Chief, Donald Sullivan, to discuss a personnel issue. Discussed maintaining better communication between departments. Donald stated that his secretary, Meredith Hirtle had resigned. NPS ended at 8:35PM.
