SELECTMENS MEETING
MAY 6, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: John purchased a 1996 John Deere loader on May 5th for \$38,500 per the Board's approval at a prior meeting. Approved a veteran's credit application for John Belko of 816 Murray Hill Road (R3-53). Denied a veterans credit application for Lawrence Plante of 47 Ferrin Street (V-104-10) as he does not currently qualify. Approved a tax deferral for Elaine Seibel of 885 NH Route 3A (R1-25) for the 2007 tax year in the amount of \$1945.43.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Tim Henry came in and discussed some purchases the highway dept. wants to make. The purchase of operators and maintenance manuals for the loader that was just purchased was approved as well as the parts necessary to repair the front drive shaft. The funding will come from the Highway Heavy Equipment Capital Reserve Fund as approved at town meeting. Tim asked who should be mowing around the fire station and was told that Glenn Bartis should be doing it since he is doing other mowing around town.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into NPS at approximately 7:15PM to discuss a personnel issue with Tim Henry. NPS ended at 7:45PM.

The rest of the evening was spent discussing various issues such as updating personnel policies, the Borough Road bridge project, and tracking time the highway department spends at the Transfer Station to get a better idea of how much money is being spent there.
