

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
SEPTEMBER 30, 2008

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, Linda Henry (Assistant)

ROAD AGENT: Dean and Tim attended the meeting to discuss general highway dept. business. Tim reported on the garage door quotes they received. Dean said the backhoe repair is going to be more costly than expected, but was given the go ahead to spend the money to fix it. Discussed hiring Ken Magoon to help as needed and the work being done on Borough Road.

LEON NELSON: Leon, a representative from the Andover Snowmobile Club, came in to ask permission to use the side of Currier Road for the snowmobile mobile trail again this year as he was unable to obtain permission from a property owner to use their land. Selectmen agreed having received no complaints last year. Mike signed the agreement for one year.

MISC: Selectmen reviewed information from the Coop concerning the tonnage produced from the transfer station so far this year and decided to set the guaranteed annual tonnage figure at 470 tons for 2009. Discussed the upcoming budget and the status of the Borough Road Bridge project. Evan Dietrich from Dubois and King will be asked to attend a meeting to bring the board up to date on expected costs since the project had to be postponed from last year.

SHAUN BRESNAHAN: Shaun presented the Board with a tentative schedule for the budget committee meetings and public hearings. He said that the committee would like to start the process earlier this year to allow more time to come up with a fair and thought out budget. Mike said the Board could not realistically have their budget proposal ready as early as the end of October as they are not requesting the department heads to submit their proposals until October 28th.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry expressed concern about one of the apartment buildings in town being in violation of several codes, specifically bare wiring and no smoke detectors. He said we should have a town building inspector. Mike felt the Board had no authority over this issue.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30PM.
