BETTY MEYERHOEFFER: Betty expressed concern about the bidding process for the waterworks project. It was suggested that she speak to the water commissioners.

LIBRARY TRUSTEES: Norma Kane, Martha Jordan and Anne Ford attended the meeting at the Board's request to discuss some personnel issues. They were given a copy of the Town's new employee policies to review. Everyone understood that they have the legal right to set their own policies in regard to the librarian. It was suggested that they consider adopting the same policies for their employee to be fair to the rest of the town's personnel. Norma stated that they are considering making the librarian salaried. Mike questioned that idea and stated that no town employee is salaried. They said they understood the issues at hand and will consider them.

SHAUN BRESNAHAN: Shaun stopped in briefly. Linda mentioned that the proposed date for the school public hearing will be too late to get the town reports here on time. He will revise the schedule.

BOB DUPUIS: Bob asked for information on the generator. He said that Bristol has budgeted for construction of the Borough Rd. Bridge.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry asked if there were any developments in the Robie case. He expressed concern about the time line for the school budget public hearing. The bid for the water project has still not been awarded. Selectmen reviewed the attorney's opinion on the matter. Gerry stated that rural development has to concur with their choice.

MISC: Selectmen discussed warrant articles and reviewed the year end budget report.
