

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMEN'S MEETING
JANURY 27, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: Selectmen discussed options for getting more lighting at the transfer station. They discussed the cruiser replacement and whether or not to keep the old one for a town vehicle. They have not met with the Police Chief as of this date to determine the final cost. The money would be coming from the capital reserve created for that purpose. The budget and warrant articles were discussed. Gerry Desrochers spoke about a web-site that information concerning town meeting can be sent to in an effort to inform the public of important matters. Selectmen approved. A building permit was issued to Chris DeAngelis to build a camp on Currier Rd. (R12-39-1).

WATER DEPT: Commissioners Desrochers and Weinert along with Andy Sharpe from the engineering firm Provan & Lorber came in to discuss the water project. Andy handed out a tabulation of bids received. The lowest bidder included penny bids which went against the bid requirements and therefore could not be awarded the bid. Town council concurs that it is correct to handle it this way. The bid will be awarded to James Piscopo General Contractor, Inc. of Winnisquam NH. Mike made a motion to accept the bid with Piscopo, John seconded. A letter was signed to DES as well as the notice of award. Andy also submitted a letter stating the cost increases incurred through his firm in the amount of \$16,600. He said we are in good shape overall at this time. Mike signed the amendment to the contract.

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Briefly discussed the Borough Rd. bridge project. There will be a warrant article again this year to construct the new bridge. Bristol is apparently going to put it on their warrant again, but no one knows if it will pass. Discussed how to deal with the article if they don't agree to help. Bristol wants to know if we have a right-of-way on North Rd. as another possible means of access to Borough Rd. There is some uncertainty about this and will be looked into. If not, Mike will draft a letter to the Bristol Select Board.
