

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
FEBRUARY 10, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MIKE STANLEY: Mike asked the Board if they were interested in pursuing the single stream recycling option which he had spoken about previously. One container would replace the paper and recyclable containers that we currently have at the transfer station.

MARTHA JORDAN: Martha expressed concern about the cuts made to the Library Trustees 2009 budget request. She said they would not be able to offer an adequate pay increase to the librarian and still have money to purchase new books.

MISC: General discussion took place regarding the 2009 budget. Discussed options for funding the Borough Rd. Bridge replacement project should the Town of Bristol not approve their warrant article to fund half of the projected cost. Discussed when we should hold the annual town meeting. A motion was made to hold the meeting on March 19th, a week later than usual. All agreed. The school will be contacted to see if they would be willing to change their date to another week so that we would not be holding both the school and town meetings the same week. Also discussed the use of the town cruiser on class VI roads due to the poor condition of some of them. Selectmen voted to not recommend the purchase of the new fire truck as required since it is a petitioned article. Selectmen reviewed the tax map to see if there are any town owned lots that could be logged.

SHAUN BRESNAHAN: Shaun stopped in briefly. Discussed using the Ferrin Fund this year. The consensus was that this is not a good time to use it due to the economy.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 8:15PM.
