

TOWN OF HILL  
SELECTMENS MEETING  
FEBRUARY 17, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: Selectmen briefly discussed doing some logging on town owned lots, but found that there is nothing worth harvesting at this time. Discussed a police dept. personnel issue. Selectmen discussed the budget committee's recommendation to add a warrant article to create a capital reserve fund for archival preservation, but voted to not include it at this time.

POLICE CHIEF: Chief Kratz came in and discussed general police dept. business. He turned in the information needed to complete his background check. He said the cruiser needed some repair. Most of the equipment from the old cruiser can be reused on the new one. Selectmen told him that they did not want the dept. to patrol on Class VI roads, due to poor road conditions. He stated that they don't normally take the cruiser on to these roads unless it is necessary.

TRANSFER STATION: Jim Prescher and Liz Bedard from the Concord Regional Solid Waste Cooperative along with Mike Stanley came in to discuss the possibility of converting to single stream recycling. A presentation was given. Basically any household recyclables; plastics, cans, paper would be collected in one container. It will accept all plastics, not just #1 and 2. There would be no capital investment. They would like an answer by the end of May.

TOWN HALL USE: Selectmen approved an application to use the town hall on April 11<sup>th</sup> for a bridal shower with terms to be arranged later. Also approved an application for the Historical Society to use the gym on March 26<sup>th</sup>.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30PM.
