MISC: Mike spoke about the possibility of obtaining federal bridge funding in light of the stimulus package. He said we would be starting work on the water project early April. Discussed single stream recycling and general transfer station business. An extension of building permit #0405 was approved for Chuck Denningham, V-32.

TOWN HALL USE: Selectmen discussed revising the town hall rental fees and decided to keep them the same as the previous. The security deposit will be increased to \$75.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry said there may be funding available from the stimulus plan to do additional work on the water lines. It was agreed that we should submit the application since it does not require us to participate. It would require another town meeting as money would have to be appropriated. He also reported that there has been a lot of activity on the town web-site.
