SELECTMENS MEETING
MARCH 3, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

POLICE DEPT: Mike made a motion to require that all purchases be pre approved for the Police Department. All agreed. Selectmen decided not to require Chief Kratz to submit to a polygraph test as recommended by the county Sheriff's office. The background check report should be completed by the end of the week.

MISC: Discussed work that needs to be done on the town office building. Approved a veteran's credit for Lawrence Plante, (V-104-10) and a total disability veteran's credit for Richard Wright (R3-54). Reviewed letter from the assessor regarding the current use change tax bill for lot R10-8 owned by the Caroline Robie Rev. Trust. The assessor recommends lowering the change tax to \$1,500. Selectmen agreed. Received another letter from Mildred Shamon (R8-1) requesting an abatement of the interest that has accrued on her property taxes. She claims that she never received a tax bill, but the Board denied the request.

TAX DEEDED PROPERTY: Selectmen received a letter from Albert Moriarity who is interested in purchasing a town owned lot on Kenniston Rd. (R8-23). Mike said that the town attorney told him in the past that we can sell tax deeded property for more than the back taxes, interest, etc. after a certain period of time has passed. More research will need to be done before making any decision on the request.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry asked Mike to sign a payment voucher for the water project.
