SELECTMENS MEETING  
MARCH 10, 2009

HIGHWAY DEPT: Dean and Dale Wheeler came in to discuss the new personnel policies that the Board requested they review and provide input on before implementing them. Most of the discussion focused on not losing their paid time off that has accumulated over the years. We also discussed a bi-weekly pay period and adding disability insurance to the benefits. Brief discussion took place regarding road conditions and the school bus using Bunker Hill Rd. in the afternoon route, which no one thought was a good idea. Mike stated that the Board as no authority to stop it if they choose to proceed.

MISC: Discussed the possibility of receiving additional funding for construction of the Borough Rd. Bridge through the federal stimulus plan. The Bristol Town Manager will be attending the meeting on Friday at the DOT to gather more information about this. General discussion regarding Class VI roads took place. An intent to excavate was signed for J.P. Morrison (R1-28) as well as the excavation tax warrant for 2008-2009. A current use application was approved for Faith Knowles (R3-43, R3-48, R3-49). A land use change tax warrant was signed for Caroline Robie Trust (R10-8).

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry asked if the Board had any issues with starting a page for local vendors and other organizations on the town web-site. Selectmen thought it would be a good idea as long as there is a disclaimer stating that the town does not endorse anyone.
