SELECTMENS MEETING  
MARCH 17, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

ROAD AGENT: Dean expressed his concern again about the decision to take the school bus up Bunker Hill Road. Selectmen had also expressed their opposition to the school Board, but they elected to take this action anyway. He also asked for police involvement to stop the dirt bikes from tearing up dirt roads; Dearborn and Frost specifically. This has been going on for the last 8 to 10 years according to Dean. Chief Kratz responded that someone is on duty 6 days a week at this time and they will keep an eye out.

MISC: Mike stated that we have an excellent chance of obtaining funding from the Federal Stimulus Plan for construction of the Borough Rd. Bridge, but that more red tape will be required. The Town of Bristol passed the article to assist us funding 10% of the cost of the project. Yield tax warrant and intent to cut was signed. Approved use of the town hall for a Girl Scout sleepover in April and the Hill Youth League for softball practices on Sundays from March – June. Mike was chosen to be Chairman of the Select Board for another year.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz discussed his suggestion to start a Highway Safety committee so that funding could be obtained for various projects. Bob Dupuis was recommended to be a member. Discussed getting rid of the cell phone and switching to a less expensive software to reduce maintenance costs.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05PM.
