

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
APRIL 14, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

ROAD AGENT: Dean asked to have Ken Magoon help him for a while until a new highway worker was hired. He will also be asked to do the mowing again per Dean's request. Selectmen agreed. Briefly discussed the water project in relation to being able to use the roads while the road ban is in effect. NH Electric Coop will be relocating poles on Borough Rd. in preparation for construction of the bridge. Also discussed the driveway issue on Addison Rd. Mike stated that we have no authority over that as it is the Planning Board who regulates driveways.

SHAUN BRESNAHAN: Shaun was sworn in as a Zoning Board member term to expire in 2012.

POLICE CHIEF: Dave gave the Board a report on police activity in town. He said we may not be able to get the cruiser or it may take up to 12 weeks for delivery. It is possible that we will have to get a different one. Dave presented a written explanation for a recent complaint concerning how a traffic violation was handled and was satisfied with the officer's story.

JAMES COLE: Mr. Cole came in to inquire about opening an auto repair business on King Rd. There is already a garage on the property. Selectmen said they did not see a problem, but he should check with the Planning Board to make sure.

MISC: Discussed a Transfer Station personnel issue. Signed wage increase authorizations made retro from the week of 3/22/09. An addition error was made on the MS-7 which resulted in a \$355 deficit within the operating budget. It was determined that it would be taken out of the Fire Dept. protective clothing line.

TOWN CLERK: Desiree presented her reworked budget to the Board per their request due to the Budget Committee's recommendation to level fund the department. Selectmen agreed to the changes which allowed for the assistant T/C to receive the wage increase that was originally requested.

WATERWORKS: Gerry Desrochers and Gerry Weinert requested that Dave Hemeon be appointed as a Water Commissioner. All agreed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30PM.
