SELECTMENS MEETING
APRIL 28, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

SHELLY HENRY: Shelly presented the selectmen with two applications for a new school board member. Per RSA 197:26, the selectmen must choose the individual if the current members disagree with which candidate is best suited for the position. After reviewing the applications, the selectmen voted unanimously for Karen Hildreth.

TOWN ASSESSOR: Jim Rice came in per the Board's request to discuss the upcoming cyclical update. The information will be on line for property owners to view and compare with other properties. The selectmen requested that the dollar value for views be put on the property record card. The general assessing contract was signed.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Nps began at 7:15PM. Selectmen met with Dean Wheeler, Chief Kratz and Officer Mahoney to discuss an issue of concern. Also reviewed an assistance application. Nps ended at 7:30PM.

ROAD AGENT: Dean and the Board reviewed the applications for the heavy equipment operator. Four candidates were chosen for interviews to be held next Tuesday evening.

POLICE CHIEF: Dave expressed concern that we may not be able to get the new cruiser due to the problems with General Motors.

MISC: Selectmen signed an intent to cut for J. Christopher (R1-36), R. Stockley (R1-14) and V. Dickinson (R1-15). Yield tax warrants were signed. Building permit was approved for E. Elliott, 16 Crescent St. (V-10). Selectmen signed appointment forms for Desiree Mahurin and Karen Welch for Park & Recreation Committee members and Julie Hunter for Library Trustee alternate. They also voted to accept the single stream recycling option for the transfer station.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Mike signed a right of way certificate for the water project. Gerry said that the contractor should be moving equipment in this week.

TAX COLLECTOR: Desiree brought up an issue of concern revolving around a mobile home in the trailer park (56 Park St.) that was apparently moved without a permit resulting in the possible loss of tax revenue. She will do what she can to try and collect the taxes.
