SELECTMENS MEETING  
MAY 5, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

MISC: The ambulance contract with the Town of Bristol was signed. A building permit was approved for Norman Holt to build a camp on Poverty Pond Rd. (R13-24-1).

POLICE CHIEF: Joe McComiskey, our new police officer, was sworn in. Chief Kratz reported that the cruiser has transmission problems again. The new cruiser should take about 9 weeks to get here. They are not getting the grant that they applied for due to matching funds not being available at this time.

INTERVIEWS: At 7PM the Selectmen began interviews with potential highway dept. heavy equipment operator candidates. Interviews concluded at approximately 8PM. The Board later discussed the applicants with the road agent and suggested two possibilities for him to interview himself.

WYTHE ISSUE: Kathy Wythe and her daughter Carol came in after leaving a letter for the Board to review last week. They stated that they were going to rebuild the portion of the stone wall in front of their home on Bunker Hill Rd. in order to correct the drainage problem they are having. They claim that the town knocked it down and that is the cause of their problems. John stated there would be no point in doing that. It would not resolve the issue and suggested installing a two foot culvert under their driveway. Mike stated the Board is in no way giving them permission to do this or to change the drainage of the road and advised against it. They would be liable for any damages. John said he would like to take a look at the situation himself as he is not familiar with the issue. Kathy stated he was welcome to do so. This has been an ongoing issue for many years.
