STEVE CARTER: Steve stopped in to offer to pay part of the expense to fix the Transfer station fence damaged in an auto accident that he was involved in. Selectmen accepted his offer to pay \$500 at \$100 per week.

POLICE CHIEF: Dave said he ordered the new cruiser, a Ford Expedition. More repairs are needed to keep the current cruiser running. Selectmen advised him to only get absolutely necessary repairs until the new cruiser is delivered.

ROAD AGENT: Discussed repainting the transfer station building. Glenn has offered to do it. Also discussed how to get rid of the used oil at the transfer station as it is contaminated with antifreeze. Job applicants were discussed, but no decision has been made yet. Dean said he will be out for a couple of weeks starting on May 26<sup>th</sup> for medical reasons. Briefly discussed the Wythe water run-off issue. John made some suggestions, but nothing was decided.

MISC: Selectmen signed an excavation tax warrant. A building permit to install a new mobile home was approved for 56 Park St. (R9-53-D1).
