SELECTMENS MEETING
MAY 19, 2009

HIGHWAY DEPT: Dean came in with our new highway dept. worker, Dean Stevenson. His rate of pay was discussed and it was decided to start him at \$12 per hour until he receives his CDL license. At that time his rate would increase to \$12.50 per hour should he pass his 90 day review. Selectmen gave permission to have Glenn Bartis paint the transfer station building and pick up the supplies.

KIM MOYER: Kim requested information on the Borough Rd. bridge project as she is an abutter. She said that phone poles have been removed and trees cut down. She requested to be kept informed of developments as the project gets underway.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 7:15PM to meet with an assistance client. Nps ended at 7:30PM.

RON TRUDEL: Ron voiced a complaint about the horses next door to his property on 10th Mountain Rd. He has been bothered by the odor and bugs that they produce. He claims the current owner bought the land in 2002 and built a paddock. He feels the zoning regulations do not allow for this. The selectmen said they would look into the situation. Mike will speak to the Planning Board at their next meeting.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry stopped in briefly to have Mike sign documents for the waterworks project.

MISC: Yield tax warrants were signed. An intent to cut was signed for Seymour Goldberg (R8-13, 7-6, 7-11, 7-12) and Perras Lumber for a continuation of the logging operation in Wade State Forest. The engagement letter was signed with Plodzick and Sanderson to perform the "2008" audit. Selectmen received a letter from the State that we have been chosen to receive federal funding for the Borough Rd. Bridge Construction Project. This will cover 100% of the construction costs. An amendment to the agreement with Dubois & King was signed due to the anticipated federal funding requirements
