MISC: Mike said he spoke to the Planning Board about horses in the village and they don't have any issue in the case presented to the Board last week. Discussed the ARRA workshop that Linda attended to do with the Borough Rd. bridge project. A lien release was signed for an assistance case. The Ferrin Fund interest letter request was signed. Selectmen appointed Parker Morgan as a Trustee of the Trust Funds. A building permit was approved for Matthew Sylvestre of 571 Currier Rd. (R13-31-1A). Discussed the short and long term disability options that the Board is considering including in the benefits package. Not sure at this time if employee contributions would be required.

LIBRARY: Library Trustees, Norma Kane, Ann Ford and Gail Seip attended the meeting to discuss the library appropriation. In light of the cash flow situation, the Board had asked them how much money they needed to get by for a few months until the cash flow improved. Wages for the librarian were discussed. Norma said they would like to get new computers as the current ones are out dated and offer computer classes for adults. They count on the interest that the money provides for additional revenue. They have received many grants in the past and continue to look for more funding so that they don't have to ask for more tax dollars.
