

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
JUNE 9, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

NED GORDON: Mr. Gordon came in to discuss the removal of large rocks on his property on Borough Road that were apparently moved there when the highway department reconstructed the road. Not sure if they are on or off the right-of-way, but John felt they were off the right-of-way. They need to be broken up in order to move them and it will be expensive to rent the required equipment. A letter will be sent to Mr. Gordon assuring him that the rocks will be moved within a 14 month time frame. Mr. Gordon was satisfied with that agreement.

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Nancy Mayville from DOT, Paul Weston, Bristol Town Administrator and Don Milbrand, Bristol Selectman attended the meeting to discuss how we will be proceeding with the bridge project. Nancy gave an overview of how things will progress and where the funding is actually coming from. Close to full time inspection will be required. Nancy said we have to be under contract by March 1, 2010, but since a lot of the work has already been done we expect it to be much sooner. The town of Hill will be spearheading the project and making all the payments. DOT will then reimburse us on a monthly basis. Mike asked about hiring a Clerk of the Works and was told that funding could possibly be obtained for that position. Paul will draft up an agreement between the two towns for future maintenance of the bridge in which we will share equally. Nancy left a municipal agreement for us to sign. Selectmen will review prior to signing.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Dale Wheeler came in to discuss general highway dept. business in Dean's absence. The international was repaired in December 2008, but is having problems again. John will discuss this with Vinnie's Truck Repair.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 7:55PM to meet with a potential assistance client. Nps ended at 8PM.

MISC: A building permit application was approved for Jesse Reese, 18 Evergreen Lane, (R3-9-2). Selectmen voted to deny the current use change tax abatement application for the Caroline Robie Rev. Trust (R10-8) per the assessor's recommendation. The tax deed list provided by the tax collector was reviewed. The Board wants to wait another week to make any decisions.

WATER DEPT: Gerry Desrochers had Mike sign a request for disbursement for the water project. Contract #2 will be awarded to Edmunds per the Selectmen's vote and Gerry's recommendation.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30PM.
