SELECTMENS MEETING  
JUNE 16, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Selectmen)

ROAD AGENT: Discussion took place regarding the repair of the international. The starter may need to be replaced.

MARK HANEY: Mark asked about his great uncle, Roy Jones, not being on the veteran's memorial monument. He served in the Korean War and recently passed away. The matter will be looked into.

AL SANDERSON: Al asked whether or not there would be any parking issues on Old Town Rd. as his daughter is getting married in July. Selectmen had no particular issues, but suggested that he speak to the Police Chief.

FIRE CHIEF: Discussion took place regarding the purchase of a used fire truck as approved at the annual town meeting. Selectmen told Matt they would prefer a 6 man vehicle with a 1,000 gallon tank and a 1250 pump. Matt will continue looking.

MISHA BOZARTH: Misha came in to discuss the taxes due on her Uncle's property. She said the building is badly deteriorated and asked about a tax abatement. She was given an abatement application.

MARK COFFIN: Mark asked the Board if he could paint the town office building as part of his community service. He also mentioned that he could do computer work as well. Mike suggested that he also contact the school. The Selectmen will discuss it and let him know later.

TAX COLLECTOR: Desiree gave the Board an updated deed list with only three property owners remaining. She said one option for collection is to take them to small claims court. Letters will be sent asking them to contact the Selectmen to discuss the matter.

MISC: Linda received a complaint about trucks using Dearborn Rd. even though there is a no thru trucking sign posted. This is the second complaint. Chief Kratz will be notified. The Bridge contract with the State will be forwarded to the town attorney for review prior to signing. The letter of commitment was signed for the Household Hazardous Waste Day which will be held on July 25<sup>th</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>. Yield tax warrants were signed. An assistance application was reviewed.
