SELECTMENS MEETING
JULY 14, 2009

MISC: Selectmen received a letter from Kathy Wythe concerning the water run-off issue at her property on Bunker Hill Rd. This letter was in response to their concerns about the stone wall belonging to their neighbors discussed at a previous meeting with her. She was not satisfied with the Boards remedy to the situation. A building permit to install a 4x4 "For Sale" sign was approved for the Robie property on Murray Hill Rd. and Rte. 3A. Mike signed a cemetery lot deed for Bunker Hill Cemetery. Selectmen signed a deed waiver for Manfred Arndt (R3-3-3). The new employment policies were reviewed briefly, but not finalized yet.

FIRE DEPT: Matt presented some fire truck options for the Boards review. Gerry Desrochers urged them to make a decision soon as the water tank will be off line soon due to the water improvement project. Matt will find out where these vehicles are located and then make his recommendation.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Selectmen entered into nps at 7:20pm to meet with a possible assistance client. Nps ended at 7:35pm.

TREE ISSUE: Marsha and Alan Duhamel and Lindsay Bush came in to inquire about cutting some trees on their property on Mountain View Rd. (V26, V27). Their properties abut town land and they were not sure where the boundaries are. Selectmen went out to look with them. After measuring based on measurements from the tax maps they determined that the trees are on their own property.
