POLICE DEPT: Selectmen took a look at the new cruiser and discussed the best way to dispose of the old one. Chief Kratz reported that there have been 232 calls for service so far this year.

FIRE DEPT: Chief Desrochers obtained more information on vehicles one of which is located in Wisconsin. Much discussion was had on the subject. Matt said that two members of the department are enrolled in the fire science program at the Tech. He would like to begin an internship program by having them work at the station Monday – Friday from 8-4pm unless they have class. This would be a volunteer program. They would not receive any pay unless they go out on a call. Selectmen agreed.

PAULA MCDONOUGH: Paula asked if there were any issues regarding taking in rescue dogs. There are no issues.

MISC: Selectmen agreed that the Highway dept. should do the mowing, but no tree cutting would be done this year due to budget constraints. A 2008 property tax abatement was granted to Misha Bozart (R7-23). A promissory note was signed for David Beudet (R9-53-A2) in lieu of a tax collector deed.

GERRY DESROCHERS: Gerry reported on the status of the water works project. Bids came in for Contract #3 but not awarded yet. He gave the Board a copy of a petition from the Ferrin St. extension residents to extend the water main to the end of the cul-de-sac.
