MARK FLINT: Mr. Flint came in to make a request to “buy” back his property (R4-10) taken recently for non payment of taxes. He was prepared to pay what he owes on the property. After consulting with the Tax Collector, it was determined that more needs to be done to figure the actual “buy-back” cost. Desiree will obtain that figure within the next couple of weeks. The town attorney will also be consulted to make sure that proper procedures are followed. Mr. Flint also brought up an issue concerning the possibility that his neighbor built a home on his property.

MISC: An assistance application was reviewed. Appointment forms were signed for Bill Henry, Planning Board and Seymour Goldberg, alternate.

WATERWORKS: Gerry Desrochers had Mike sign another payment request for the project. Mike made a motion to accept the lowest bid for painting the water tank which came in at \$213,300 from Modern Protective Coatings pending approval from Rural Development. John seconded. All agreed. Discussion ensued regarding the Johnson lawsuit. A joint meeting will be arranged with the Selectmen, Water Commissioners and attorney assigned to the case.
