SELECTMENS MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 15, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

ANNE FORD: Anne expressed concern about dogs being allowed to run around the transfer station facility. The Board shared her concern and will speak to the attendants to monitor that.

KATIE GRAY: Katie voiced concern about a recent incident at the transfer station involving one of the attendant's behavior. Selectmen stated that the attendants have to use their own discretion regarding "stuff" being left out for people to take.

MATT MARKIEWICZ: Matt came in per the Boards request to discuss using the town hall facility for the Boy Scout meetings on Thursday nights. There have been some issues regarding using space that the school needs for storage. After a brief discussion the Board approved his application to use the building again this year.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz introduced a new part-time officer, Richard Riley.

FIRE DEPT: Chief Desrochers presented another option for a fire truck to the Board. This one is located in New York. John had an option for one in New York as well. Due to the distance, they will postpone looking at the one in Alabama as discussed at a previous meeting and will arrange to go see these vehicles. Matt received a grant in the amount of \$5,800 from Franklin Savings Bank to purchase AED's. We will check into whether or not a public hearing will need to be held prior to accepting the funds.

MISC: The following building permits were approved: Michael Munson, R13-18-1 to build a new home, David Thomson, R10-5-1 garage, Lisa Punderson, R12-21 installation of new mobile home. Since the school is not involved in the fuel consortium this year, the Board elected to see if AD & G would give the town the same deal as the school at \$1.90 per gallon.
