

TOWN OF HILL
SELECTMENS MEETING
OCTOBER 6, 2009

Present: Mike Brady, Mark Dow, John Lynch, Linda Henry (Assistant)

FIRE DEPT: Chief Desrochers came in and they all discussed fire trucks. Looked at some other options, but nothing found was suitable. The search will continue. Matt suggested that we meet with Danbury and Alexandria to discuss what can be done about the expected ambulance increase next year. Matt is also looking into working something out with Franklin.

PUBLIC HEARING: A public hearing was held at 7:05pm to accept a grant obtained by the Fire Dept. from the NH Charitable Foundation in the amount of \$5,800 to purchase AED's. With no public in attendance the Board voted to accept the grant.

WYTHE ISSUE: Discussed the Wythe water run-off issue on Bunker Hill Rd. Linda reported that Mr. Biondi did not wish to get involved and prefers not to attend a meeting at this time. He was told by the Wythe's that they had permission to repair the stone wall, but did not state by whom. The town did not give permission to do this. The matter will be looked into further prior to taking any other action.

MISC: Selectmen approved use of the town hall for a Girl Scout Leader meeting on October 6th and an event given by Mike Hines on October 24th.

Building permits were approved for Shane Smith, 194 Old Town Rd. (R9-54) to build a deck and John Barker, 821 Murray Hill Rd. (R3-58) for demo work.

Selectmen regretfully accepted the resignation of Glenn Bartis. They discussed the need to have two attendants on duty at the transfer station. Discussed getting new signs for the facility. Linda mentioned that NH the Beautiful offers free signs each year for that purpose.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30pm.
