REVALUATION: Discussion took place regarding the town wide revaluation that was completed this year. John has issues with the number of people who still have concerns with their property values. He suggested using the old values to complete the MS-1 which is part of the equation in determining the tax rate. The Dept. of Revenue will be contacted to see if that is possible. He also would like to give those tax payers who are not satisfied with their assessment another opportunity to meet with the assessor to review their property record.

MISC: Approved use of the town hall for a Girl Scout sleepover on November 13th. A vote was taken to close the access to Borough Rd on the Bristol side with a seven day advance notice if necessary during the construction of the new bridge. Mike was absent at the time, but Mark and John both agreed.

Selectmen discussed the current use change tax issue as mentioned last week. John expressed concern about how much land is actually being used and questioned the assessor's judgment on the matter. Also discussed commercial zoning.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 8pm.
