FIRE DEPT: After viewing a fire truck today, the Board voted to offer \$80,000 for it which will include all necessary repairs. Chief Desrochers estimated that it would cost an additional \$6,000 for equipment.

LIBRARY: Trustees, Gayle Seip, Norma Kane and Anne Ford presented the 2010 budget proposal.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz presented his 2010 budget proposal.

MISC: Selectmen signed the MS-5. Intents to cut were signed for Michael Bucklin (R4-13) and Parker Morgan (R4-5, R4-6).

Selectmen discussed the school payments. Is there a better way to make them so it is less of a burden on the town cash flow?

Selectmen discussed dump stickers. We will use up our current supply and change the date to 2010 to cut down on cost.

Discussed the flood control reimbursement. Several people are involved in trying to increase our revenue in light of the assessed value being drastically reduced this year and the State cracking down on this issue.

BOROUGH RD. BRIDGE: Mike made a motion to award the construction contract to A.J. Coleman and Son for \$928,738 as they were the lowest bidder. One hundred percent of the funding will come from the State and Federal government.
