SELECTMEN'S MEETING
DECEMBER 22, 2009

HIGHWAY DEPT: The road agent came in to talk about upcoming vehicle repair expenses and possible replacement. Discussed gravel crushing as the stock is running low. This will be put in as a warrant article to start a capital reserve fund at the 2010 town meeting.

SCHOOL ISSUE: Karen Hildreth expressed concern as a school board member and parent about the school payments which are currently in arrears. She was concerned about the possible repercussions of not paying in a timely manner. The Board told her that due to the tax rate being set late, we cannot catch up until tax payments start to come in which should be any time now.

FIRE DEPT: Acting Chief Dee Ford submitted purchase orders to outfit the new fire truck.

MISC: Selectmen discussed short term disability options and decided to offer eligible employees a 60% 26 week option. The cost would be \$41.73 per month for all three eligible employees and would be covered 100% by the town. The 2010 health insurance agreement was signed.

Selectmen decided to have the assessor handle the Robie current use change tax appeal with the Board of Tax and Land appeals.

Signed an intent to cut for Albert Moriarty (R8-20, R8-21).

WATER DEPT: Gerry submitted documents concerning the water project.
