SELECTMEN'S MEETING
JANUARY 5, 2010

FIRE DEPT: Acting Chief Deanna Ford dropped off year end purchase orders.

POLICE DEPT: Chief Kratz dropped off year end purchase orders.

MISC: Reviewed an assistance application. Selectmen will need to meet with the applicant next week.

Approved an abatement request for Peter Nogue (R9-53-C5) 43 Park St. as the trailer burned down last year.

Selectmen discussed the generator contract. They will look into finding someone locally to do this.

Selectmen discussed warrant articles for the annual town meeting. They will ask for \$46,829 to be put into the Road Improvement Capital Reserve Fund. This money represents the unspent Block Grant.

They will also ask to take \$100,000 from the Highway Heavy Equipment Capital Reserve Fund to purchase a new cab & chassis to replace the 1990 International.

Another article will ask to start a new capital reserve fund for gravel crushing in the amount of \$20,000.

Selectmen will also suggest an article that will require spending approximately \$10,000 to get an independent appraisal of the flood control land due to the State's lowering our reimbursement substantially.

Briefly discussed plowing methods and routes.
