RICK VINCENT: Rick stopped in briefly to inquire about the town assessor position. He was told the Board will be sending out request for proposals in the spring.

NON PUBLIC SESSION: Entered into nps at 6:45pm to meet with an assistance client. Nps ended at 6:55pm.

MISC: A couple inquired about property on Moses Ave (R10-34-1) they are interested in purchasing. Selectmen said they are only concerned with set-backs and zoning issues being met.

General discussion regarding the condition of town bridges. Linda will call Dubois & King to inquire about the status of payment for the work done on the Borough Rd. Bridge so far.

Discussed warrant articles for the upcoming town meeting.

The 98 international was down for repair, but has since been fixed.

Voted to accept the proposal for annual generator maintenance from Lift Trucks Plus for \$200, a significant savings over Southwick Milton.

WATER DEPT: Gerry Desrochers said that DES has no issue with the Robie farm purchase in regards to it becoming an organic dairy farm.

Discussed the petition that was received from the Ferrin St. residents earlier this year regarding extending the water lines to the homes on the cul-de-sac.
